

Directions to SDR Studio

Unit 804 Bree Castle, 68 Bree Street, Cape Town, South Africa

Location?

SDR Photo is located at 68 Bree Street. This is the corner of Bree and Castle Streets in the Cape Town CBD. Our building is called Bree Castle, and the entrance is next to the gray Twice International showroom. We're on the 8th floor, unit 804.

How to get there?

Depending on the direction you're coming from, the easiest way is to aim for Strand Street, and turn in Bree Street, and we'll be on your right hand side 100m up on the 2nd block.

If you're coming from the N2 side (Southern Suburbs / Airport), take the first CBD offramp for Strand Street. This is right next to the Goodhope Centre. Follow Strand Street through all the traffic lights and halfway up the hill, turn left into Bree.

If you're coming from the N1 side (West Coast / Northern Suburbs / Green Point / Waterfront) follow the N1 right through town as it becomes Buitengracht Street. Turn left into Strand Street at the traffic lights, and the first right is into Bree Street.

It's that easy! However getting to our building is easy, but the Cape Town Municipality has made parking a bit of a nightmare! There are often available bays outside the building, and you can pay the parking marshall. Cost is approximately R7.00 an hour for a maximum of 2 hours. Although they will often let you stay on if you come down and pay.

But where can I park all day?

There are numerous car parks for the whole day. If you pass our office on Bree Street, 2 blocks down (about 150m walking) there is the open Heritage Square parking lot. This is charged per hour and you pay upon exit. It's safe and a really quick walk down Bree Street. See the pink dot on the map to show you - we've marked it *Hour Park*.

Should you be spending the whole day at SDR Studio, we recommend one of the cheaper day parking options. Entry for the day is normally about R15.00 depending on which lot you choose. A quick walk over Buitengracht Street and down Castle Street into Bree, only takes 2 min. Or if you want free parking, look for a space in Rose Street and walk down to the studio. We've marked the area with a pink dot called *Day Park*.

Street parking only has to be paid up to 5pm during the week, and 12pm on Saturdays. The rest of the time it's free. So weekends and afterhours, we usually just pay the initial part and then stay there until we're done. And that's a 20sec walk.

That's it. We'll see you at the studio!

There are dozens of great restaurants and places to eat and relax around the studio. Heritage Square on the next block is a maze of eateries, bars and lounges. One street down and you're in the heart of Cape Town's Long Street with Green Market Square only 2min away. There are also numerous hotels surrounding our studio.
